Approved Elective Courses for the Legal Studies Minor

Among the interdisciplinary courses, only one course can be required by the students' majors or listed (or cross-listed) in the students' major departments. Interdisciplinary courses must be selected from at least two different departments outside the students' major.

If students are approved to substitute a course in their own major for LEST 401, then none of the interdisciplinary courses may come from the students' major departments.

If a student has more than one major, the two rules above will be enforced for only one of the majors (whichever one the student chooses).
